


2. OFFICE OF THE TRUST:

The Office of the Trust shall be at No.35/1, P.C.O. Road, Egmore, Chennai – 600 008 or such other place as may be found suitable from time to time.

OBJECTS OF THE TRUST:

TO PROVIDE ACTIVITIES FOR EDUCATIONAL, MEDICAL, AND SOCIAL ASSISTANCE TO ALL NEEDY PEOPLE AND RELIEF TO THE DOWN-TRODDEN, WEAKER SECTIONS, WOMEN'S, CHILDREN, PHYSICALLY, MENTALLY, & VISUALLY CHALLENGED AND EX-SERVICEMEN OF THE SOCIETY SUCH AS:

- To establish and maintain kindergarten, crèches, day care centres, nurseries, Primary, middle, secondary, higher secondary matriculation schools and colleges without profit motive.
- To establish Schools, Engineering Colleges, Medical Colleges, Professional Institutions & Technical Training Institution for the poor, destitute and down-trodden.
- To establish, maintain, run, develop, sponsor Engineering Colleges, Medical Colleges, Arts & Science Colleges, Medical Research, Institutions, Schools Polytechnics, Professional Institutions Teachers Training Schools & Industrial Schools.
- 4. The Trust will help the students for their education in Graduate and Postgraduate levels.
- 5. To establish Blood Banks, Eye Banks and to maintain Hospitals, Science Technology and Medical Research Foundations or Schools, and to register the names of Eye & Blood Donors to the needy persons.





4. TO PROMOTE AND CARRY OUT THE OBJECTIVES:

- a. The trust is empowered to apply for and receive grants and contributions from individuals, internal and external Agencies, Institutions, State and Central Government.
- b. The trust is empowered to raise loans and such funds from financial institutions and government in future.
- c. To appoint persons representatives, agents on their works on such conditions as may be thought necessary by the trust.
- d. The trust funds to be acquired or earned shall be solely utilized towards fulfilling the objects and no portion of it shall be utilized for payments to trustees by way of profit interest or dividends or otherwise. The programmes and benefits shall be open to all those who need as the case may be.


OBJECTS OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC UTILITY:

a. To carry out the objects of general public utility, not involving the carrying on of any activity in profit motive such as to establish, run, maintain and develop, public halls, cyclone relief Centers, communal riot relief centers, homes for the aged, destitute men, deprived people and children, on no loss and no profit basis.

b. FOOD & NUTRITION:

- (i) To give employment to deprived people, physically, visually, mentally & socially challenged people and ex-servicemen for the purpose of meeting their objects.
- (ii) To purchase or acquire by donation or reserve agricultural lands for the purpose of meeting the objects in future.
- (iii) To receive food, clothes and shelter for deprived persons.
- c. To accept foreign contributions on behalf of the Trust and utilize such contributions for the purpose of carrying on medical relief to the deprived persons.
- d. To do all other lawful things for obtaining of the above objects and the same shall be carried only on a no loss and no profit basis.





6. The activities of the Trust shall be confined within India and Trust shall have no power to spend money on any of the objects outside the Indian Territory.

7. BENEFICIARIES:

The Beneficiaries of the Trust shall be the economically weaker section, poor both men and deprived people, children, physically, visually mentally and socially challenged and any individual deserving the aid succor and upliftment without any distinction of case, colour, creed, sex or religion.

CONSTITUTIONS OF THE TRUST BOARD:

The Trust Board shall consist of **5** persons, one Founder President, One Founder Secretary, One Founder Treasurer and Two Trustee.

9. ADMINISTRATION:



- 3. Mr. G. GANESH, S/o. Mr. L. Gopala Krishnan aged about 37 years, residing at No.35/1, P.C.O. Road, Egmore, Chennai 600 008, as THE TREASURER.
- 4. **Dr. K. GANAPATHY** SUBRAMANIAM, S/o. Mr. L. Krishnan, aged about 35 years, residing at No.35/1, P.C.O. Road, Egmore, Chennai 600 008, as THE TRUSTEE.
- 5. Mr. K. SHANKER, S/o. Mr. L. Krishnan, aged about 30 years, residing at No.35/1, P.C.O. Road, Egmore, Chennai 600 008, as THE TRUSTEE.

10. POWERS OF THE PRESIDENT:

The President of the Trust shall be the Executive Head of the Trust. His advice shall be final in all matters pertaining to the administration of the Trust. He shall preside over all meetings, and additionally the meetings in a democratic manner.

The President of the Trust is the head who will be the Chief Administrator and he will appoint other office bearers.

11. POWERS OF THE FOUNDER:

The Founder shall hold office at his pleasure and on the vacation of office, the Founder herein on his own volition or by death or otherwise the remaining Trustees herein shall appoint the legal heirs of the deceased. They are also entitled to enjoy all the rights enjoyed by the founder.

12. POWERS OF THE SECRETARY:

- a) He shall:
 - i) Manage all the affairs of the trust.
 - ii) Convene Trust Board Meetings.
 - iii) Incur expenses accounting to the budget and produce receipt and account thereof in each Trust Board meeting.
 - iv) Have correspondence with all parties.
 - To authorize all payments to the treasurer, to give written petitions, to maintain registers, files etc., of the Trust.
- b) She is also empowered to convene Trust Board meetings, to set up office, to appoint clerk, maintain registers, files, etc., of the Trust, to regularize the aims, plans and activities of the Trust.

13. POWERS OF THE TREASURER:

He will be in charge of the accounts, and receipts for the amount in his custody, get the authorization of the Secretary for the disbursements, of money, maintain the accounts, submit the money accounts to the Secretary, and arrange for the audit of the accounts.

14. POWERS OF THE TRUSTEES:

The Trustee shall hold the trust fund on the following terms:

The Founder & Trustees shall pass resolution by circulation in case of an urgent issue. They may make rules for regulating their meetings and the Trustees may repeal later any rules made pursuant to this clause

a. To utilize the trust funds to effectuate one object or some of the objects of the Trust in preference to other object(s). To discontinue the applications of Trust funds to the objects and divert the funds to objects of the Trust.

b. To receive donations either by cash or kind of legacy or any other means from foreign countries or in India by way of corpus for on revenue account.

- c. In case it is decided to render financial or other aid to any persons or institutions within the scope of the objects, to decide the terms and conditions which shall be complied with by such persons or institutions.
- d. To determine if necessary, the terms and conditions on which any donation, subscriptions, scholarships or prizes or medals are to be given by the Trust.
- e. To expand the funds of the Trust in such manner as they consider must beneficial for the objects and purposes of the Trust.
- f. To let on hire or lease and transfer any movable or immovable properties not immediately required by the Trust to be acquired in future.
- g. To acquire any property in exchange for some other property or partly in such exchange and partly for other consideration(s) in future.
- To make and from time to time repeal add or alter regulations.
 - i) As to the Management of the Trust and affairs thereof.
 - ii) As to conduct any of the matters of things will be under the control of the Trustees provided the same shall not be in consistent with the provisions contained in these presents.
- To appoint, and remove managers, secretary, clerks and other staff and workers required for the working and general management of the affairs of the Trust.

15. BANKING ACCOUNTS:

The Trust Board shall open one or more Bank accounts in the name of the Trust. All income of subscriptions and pecuniary donations for the general purposes of the Trust and the income from investments and all other money received from time to time forming part of the general revenue of the Trust shall be deposited into one or more Banks.

The Trust Accounts should be maintained in the name of the Trust. The Bank Account will be opened by **The President and any one of the persons officially named Secretary or Treasurer** shall Jointly withdraw money.

16. ACCOUNTS & AUDIT:

The Accounting year of the Trust shall be from 1st April to 31st March every succeeding English Calendar year. The Founder and Trustees shall be responsible for maintaining proper book of Accounts with respect to.

A Chartered Accountant of a firm or Chartered Accountant shall audit the account of the Trust every year. The Board of Trustees shall appoint the C.A. of the firm every year (Explain to Section 288(2) and the Income Tax Act, 1961).

The Trust should have the necessary expertise and should maintain separate accounts in respect of the eligible project or schemes under the Income Tax Act 1961 section 35 AC, I & II.

17. VALUATION:

The Founder and Trustees herein shall maintain the list of properties acquired, administered and maintained by the Trust and the same shall always invest with the Trust.

18. ADVISORY BOARD:

The Founder and Trustees herein shall appoint advisors for better administration of their services. The Trustees shall have liberty to fix remuneration for the services rendered by the Advisors.

19. THE TRUST FUNDS:

- a) Rs.1,000/- (Corpus Amount) of the Trust.
- b) Donations to be received from any individual, public charitable institutions.
- c) Donation / assistance to be received from Government.
- d) Donation / assistance to be received from public.
- e) Gifts to be received from public and institutions.
- f) Voluntary contributions to be made with specific direction to form part of the corpus of the trust.
- g) Properties including deposits to be acquired in future.



20. GENERAL FUNCTION:


- 1. This Trust is irrevocable. If the Trust hereby constituted fail for any reason in the opinion of the Founder Trustee of the Trust, the net assets of the Trust both movable and immovable shall be hand over to any public charitable trust as decided by the majority of the Trustees, which has similar objects.
- In the event of closure or winding up, or dissolution of the Trust all its
 assets and liabilities, if any shall be transferred to another Trust which has
 similar objects and enjoying exemption which is registered under section
 12A(a), 11 and 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961.
- 3. The Exemption shall be forfeited on contravention of Section-13 of Income Tax Act, 1961.
- 4. No part of the income of the Trust shall be applied for the benefit of the President (or) Secretary (or) Treasurer (or) persons who are substantially interested u/s 13(3).
- 5. The income of the Trust shall be applied for the purpose for which it is registered as per section 11(1) or 11(2) accumulated as per section.
- 6. The income and funds of the Trust shall be solely utilized towards the objects of the Trust and the income shall be utilized for Research Centre with prior approval of The Director of Income Tax (Exemptions) Under Section 80GGA Income Tax Act, 1961.
- 7. The Trust shall invest the investment as per Section 13(1)(d) read with Sec.11(5) of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

- 8. The Income and funds of the Trust shall be solely utilized towards the objects of the Trust and no portion of its income shall be utilized for salary to loan to Trustees by way of remuneration, profit, interest, dividends, etc., in Section 13(1)© of the Income Tax Act, 1961.
- Acquisition / alienation of immovable property shall be done with prior approval of the Director of Income Tax (Exemptions) in future.
- 10. Other than objects if any amended to the instrument would be carried only with the approval of Director of Income Tax (Exemption).
- 11. To sell, alienate, lease, mortgage, charge pledge, hypothecate, transfer of otherwise deal with all properties to be acquired the assets and any amendments to the Trust Deed / Memorandum of Association / Bye-laws will be carried out only with prior approval of Director of Income Tax Exemptions.
- 12. The Benefits of the objects would be available to the general public irrespective of case, religion or sex.
- The Trust shall apply for exemption under Section 80-G in the prescribed from during the fore coming period.
- 14. The activities and functions of the Trust shall be utilized only towards charitable purpose and not for any profit motive.
- 15. Not more than 5% of the income of the Trust / institution would be applied for any religious purposes or given to religious institutions. (any violation found will lead to denial of exemption under Sec. 80G considering the Trust as Public Religious in Nature).
- 16. Other than objects if any amendments to the instrument would be carried only with the approval of Director of Income Tax (Exemption).
- 17. At present the trust has no immovable property. No activities of the Trust will be carried out anywhere outside India. The Trust shall be confined within the territorial Jurisdiction of India, with prior permission from the appropriate/ concerned authority of Director of Income Tax.
